#### The Admissions Process:

## 1. Complete an Application

First, fill out our online application packet, which includes both teen and parent/sponsor questions. These applications are shared with our mentor team to help us customize program content.

## 2. Mentor Conversation

If you or program mentors want to get to know one another further before heading out on the trail together, we are always open to meeting. If desired, we will have a 20-30 minute exchange at our central location at 1130 Napa Ave., Rm. 16, Morro Bay. ### 3. Enroll
